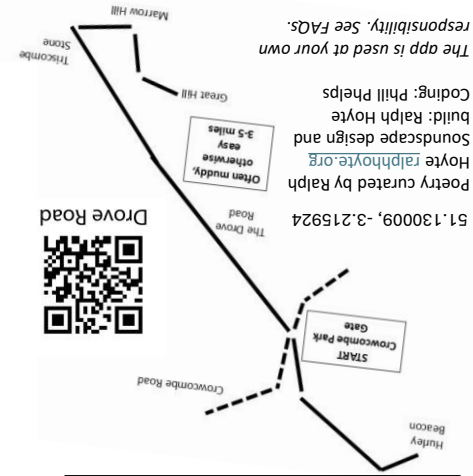

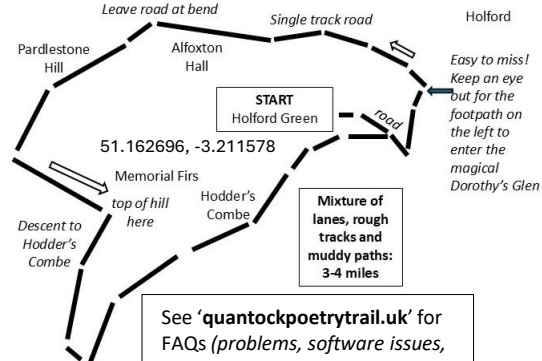

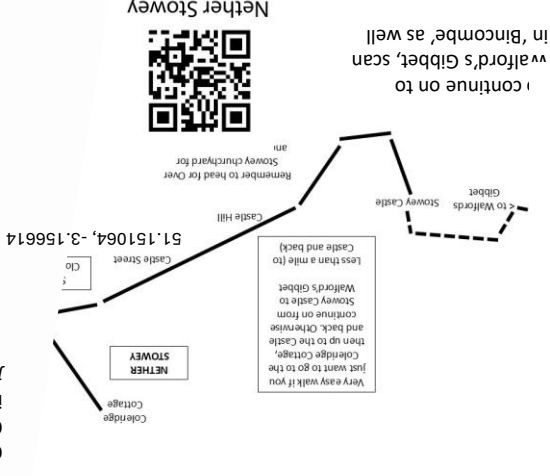

(1) To listen to the poems on location you need to download **SatsymphQR** by pointing your camera at this QR. Choose iPhone or Android (*if you already have SatsymphQR on your phone ignore this stage!*)

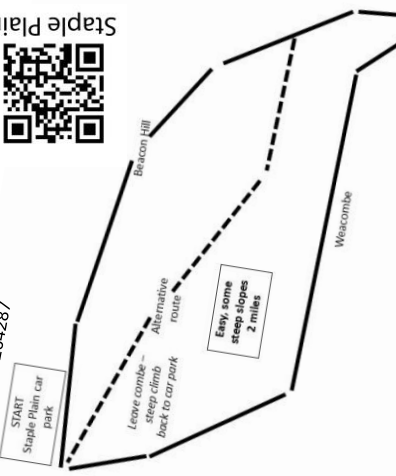
(2) Select your walk and scan it to 'Library'

(3) Go to **START** (*nb: nothing will be visible on-screen until you are at START*). Select the walk in Library. Find the soundpool labelled **START** it tells you how to find & listen to the poems on the trail.
